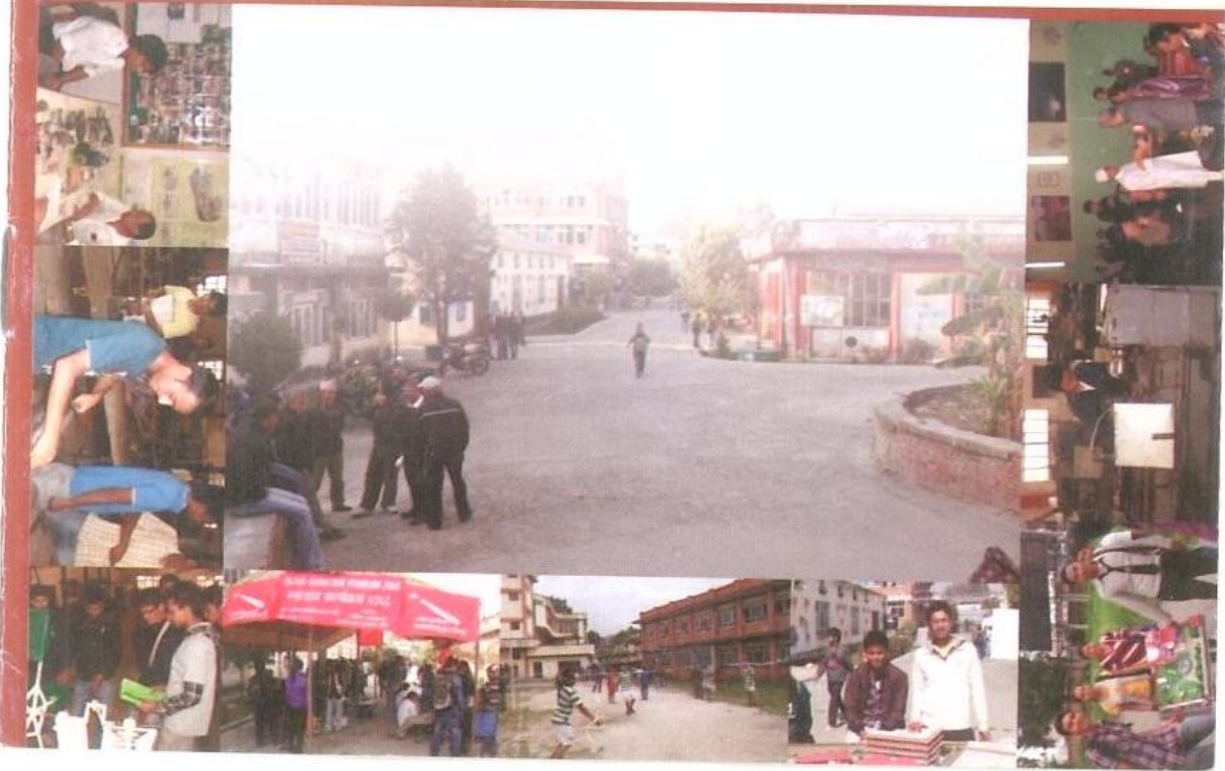

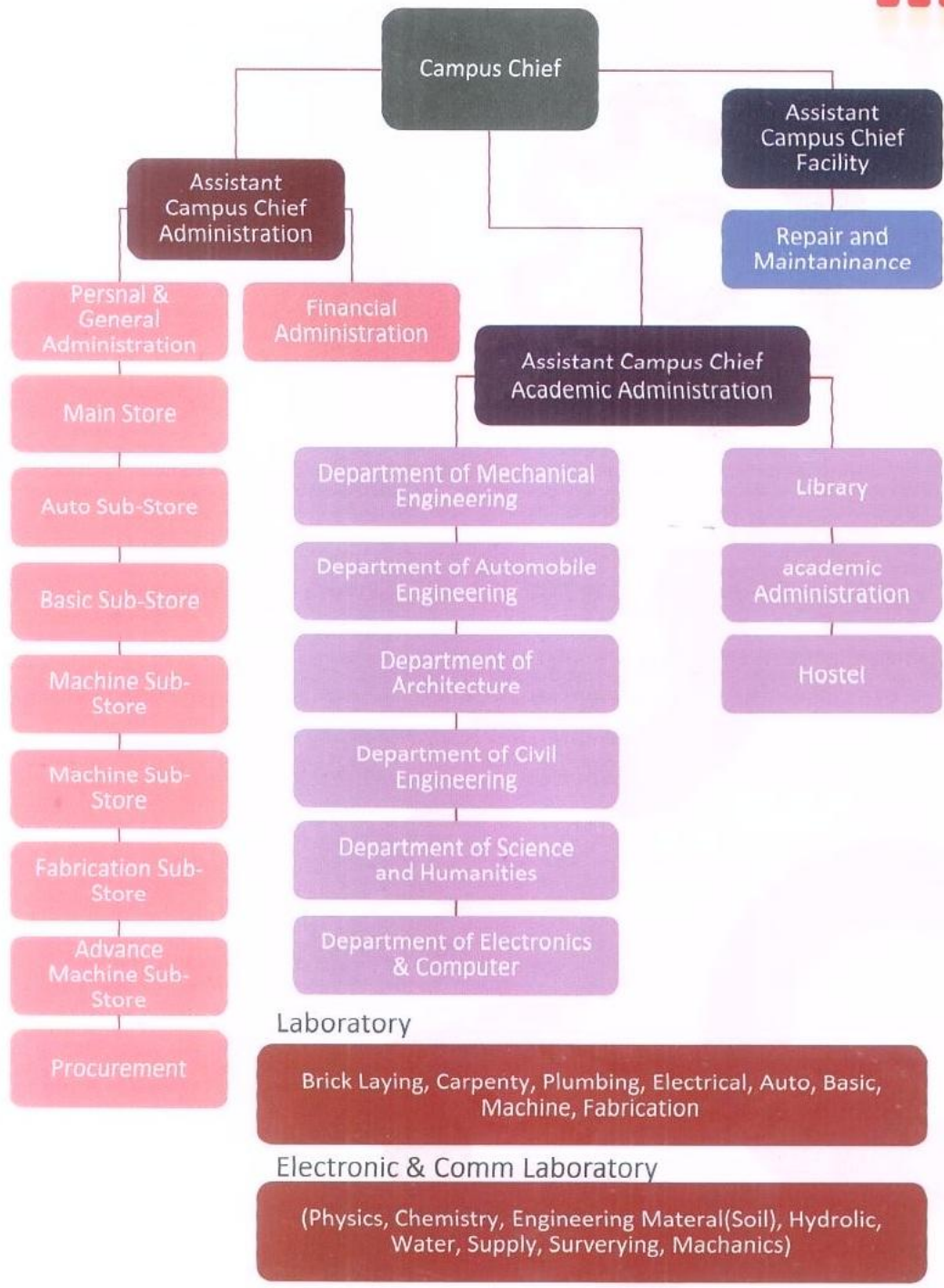

In the presence of His Majesty the King late Mahendra, Late Dr. Heinrich Lubke, President of Federal Republic of Germany inaugurated on 29th of Falgun 2023 B.S. , the Technical Training Institute(TTI) had begun offering midlevel manpower course in Mechanical Engineering, Automobile Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Mechanical Drafting.

With the assistance from the Government of Federal Republic of Germany, a Technical Training Institute Project(TTIP) was established in Nepal in 2019 B.S. , with the sole objective of producing trained tradespersons and technicians needed for the development of the country.

The institute ran 3 years' vocational training in Mechanical, Automobile and Electrical trades for class tenth passed students from 2022 B.S. to 2024 B.S. But these trainings were given to S.L.C passed students only from 2025 B.S. The three years' courses in Mechanical Drafting was run by the institute only in 2022 B.S. because this course has been transferred to Pulchowk Campus, IOE.

From 2029 B.S. this Technical Training Institute(TTI) was renamed as Thapathali Campus under attached to Tribhuvan University (T.U.) and thus known as Institute of Engineering, Thapathali Campus. Under the new education policy the campus ran 2 years' certificate courses in Mechanical and Automobile Engineering from 2031~ 2042 B.S. instead of 3 years courses in Mechanical and Automobile Engineering in diploma level since 2043 B.S. Architecture and Civil courses, which have been running in Pulchowk Campus, was shifted to this campus from 2054 B.S and 2055 B.S. respectively. From 2057 B.S. Thapathali Campus introduced full fee course in Architecture and Civil Engineering Programmes.

From 2059 B.S. Electronics, Computer Diploma.

From 2059 B.S Bachelor in Industrial Engineering, Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering.

All the diploma in engineering courses will be planed out from 2070 B.S.

Campus Objectives



To produce different levels of engineering man power needed for meeting the national aspirations and goals, Industrial Engineering, Electronics & Communication engineering.

To develop proto-type equipments, machines, etc. and undertake reach works on related field.



To conduct short-term and long-term training programs as per request by the industries or other organizations.

To provide the consultancy services and testing facilities to industries and interested organizations.





Library

The campus has a library with 30,792 books, manuals and the photocopies of the important documents and papers.

The hostel accommodates 69 students, who come from outside Kathmandu and study in the campus.



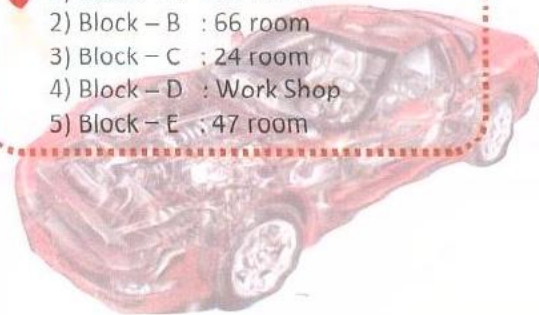
Physical Facilities - total 170 room
